ABOUT THE COLLEGE



Government Degree College Rajpora was established in the year 2019 Vide Govt. Order No. 48-HE of 2019 Dated: 05-02-2019. The College is at present functioning from a makeshift campus and is operating from Government Middle School building, BRC building and a pre-fabricated hut. The permanent campus situated near sports Stadium Rajpora is under construction which spans over 50 canals of land. Starting with its first batch of just 65 students in the year 2020 the college is imparting education to around 320 students at present. The College is affiliated to the University of Kashmir and offers courses in Arts stream with subjects Education, Political Science, Kashmiri Literature and Urdu Literature in addition to Environment Science and English. There is a sanctioned post of the Principal, 6 sanctioned posts of Teaching faculty, one PTI and 5 Non-teaching staff. The College is recognized by the UGC under 2(F) and efforts are on to get it recognized under 12(B) and accredited by the NAAC also. There is a separate staff room for the faculty and various students centric facilities like a rich Library, a Gym center, separate washrooms for boys and girls, a Browsing Center, a temporary canteen and IT enabled Classrooms with interactive digital boards. There is an active and dynamic NSS Unit which is registered with the University of Kashmir. There is internet facility in the college with 100 mbps Bandwidth which needs further improvement in terms of speed so that it is available to all the students across the campus.

PROF (DR) GAZALA GAIYAS ASSUMES CHARGE OF PRINCIPAL GDC RAJPORA

Consequent upon the appointment order of 105 confirmed principals issued by the Higher Education Department, Prof (Dr) Gazala Gaiyas assumed the charge of Principal of Degree College Rajpora on 22-12-2022 relieving Prof Syed Ifat Ara who assumed the charge of principal GDC Beerwah. Dr Gazala Gaiyas is an eminent academician and diligent researcher besides being an able administrator. Prof Syed Ifat Ara served the college as In-charge principal for nearly three years. She made a commendable contribution towards the overall development of the college which was appreciated equally by the local residents as well as the staff members and students.

The remains discovered during the Excavation show how the inhabitants of Kashmir used to live in pit dwellings. The tools recovered from the site unveil the cultural history of Kashmir.
